EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM:

The Lt. Joseph P. Kennedy School provides early childhood through high school education for children who are developmentally disabled or autistic. Students benefit from a low student to teacher ratio, in a self-contained environment, giving them a better sense of comfort and security than other school districts can offer.

RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM:

The St. Coletta's Residential Program consists of 27 group homes in the southwest suburbs of Chicago to help individuals achieve their greatest potential in the least restrictive environment. Residents take pride in their homes, participate in community activities, and patronize local stores, while learning to understand the value of being part of a community.

VOCATIONAL PROGRAM:

The goal of the St. Coletta's Vocational Program is to help special needs individuals master vocational skills that will enable them to be a productive part of society. Many of the individuals work in community supported employment programs while others perform subcontracted work at St. Coletta's Vocational Training Workshop. There are some individuals that will work in one of the specialized training rooms in a smaller and quieter environment, and others that will participate in the McDonald's Training Center which is a prototype of the McDonald's restaurant kitchen.
